Festive

Meaning: Relating to or characteristic of a celebration or festival.

Ornament

Meaning: A small, decorative object that is hung or used as an accessory, especially on a Christmas tree.

Tradition

Meaning: A belief or behavior passed down within a group or society, usually with symbolic meaning or special significance.

Jolly

Meaning: Cheerful and happy in a lively, festive way.

What makes people feel jolly during Christmas?

Sub Vocab: merriment, joyous, festive

Describe a time when you felt especially jolly during the holidays.

Sub Vocab: gleeful, lighthearted, exuberant

Why is spreading jolliness a part of Christmas cheer?

Candle

Meaning: A cylinder or block of wax with an embedded wick, lit to produce light or fragrance.



Tinsel

Meaning: Shiny, decorative material made of thin strips of metal or plastic used to give sparkle to Christmas decorations.

 Sub Vocab: embellishment, adornment, glitz

Reindeer

Meaning: A species of deer found in the northern regions, often associated with Christmas folklore and Santa Claus.

How do reindeer become part of Christmas folklore and stories?

Sub Vocab: magical, mythical, legendary

Can you name all of Santa's reindeer?

Sub Vocab: Dasher, Dancer, Prancer, Vixen, Comet, Cupid, Donder, Blitzen, Rudolph

Why are reindeer associated with Santa's sleigh?

Sub Vocab: transportation, flying, delivery





Sleigh

Meaning: A sled or light vehicle, usually horse-drawn, used for transportation or pleasure rides, often associated with Santa Claus.

- What is the significance of Santa's sleigh in Christmas tales?

 Sub Vocab: adventure, journey, magical

Mistletoe

Meaning: A plant with white berries, traditionally hung as a Christmas decoration, under which people are often expected to kiss.

What's the tradition surrounding mistletoe during Christmas?

Sub Vocab: kissing, romance, tradition

Sub Vocab: affection, love, holiday spirit

Why is mistletoe considered a symbol of love and friendship?

Wreath

Meaning: A circular band of flowers, leaves, or other materials used as a decoration, especially on doors or walls during Christmas.

1 How do people use wreaths in Christmas decor?

Sub Vocab: door, wall, festive

Sub Vocab: Evergreen, holly, berries

Why are wreaths circular and adorned with evergreen plants?

Sleigh Ride

Meaning: A recreational ride or journey in a sleigh, often associated with the holiday season.

Sub Vocab: enchanting, snowy, jovial

Sub Vocab: jingle bells, horse-drawn, scenic

Why are sleigh rides a beloved holiday activity?

Caroling

Meaning: The act of singing songs, typically religious or traditional in nature, in a group, often going door-to-door during the Christmas season.

Do you enjoy caroling during the Christmas season?

Sub Vocab: singing, harmonizing, joyful

Have you ever gone caroling with a group of people?

Sub Vocab: songs, lyrics, melody

Gingerbread

Meaning: A sweet, spiced biscuit or cake shaped and decorated to resemble a gingerbread man, house, or other festive shapes, commonly associated with Christmas.

- What is the significance of gingerbread during Christmas?

 Sub Vocab: cookies, baking, aroma

 Sub Vocab: icing, cinnamon, festive designs
- Why is gingerbread a popular holiday flavor and decoration?

Stocking

Meaning: A large sock or fabric bag, traditionally hung by the fireplace or on a mantle, to receive small gifts on Christmas Eve.

How do stockings become a part of Christmas giftgiving traditions?

Sub Vocab: Santa Claus, presents, surprise

Chestnuts

Meaning: Edible nuts produced by various species of trees, often roasted during Christmas time for their warm and cozy appeal.

 Sub Vocab: open fire, roasting, warmth
- 2 Have you ever roasted chestnuts over an open fire?

 Sub Vocab: crackling, comforting, traditional treat
- Why are chestnuts a symbol of warmth and coziness during the holiday season?
