# Pilgrim

A person who journeys to a sacred place for religious reasons.

- Who were the Pilgrims, and what is their significance in American history?
  - English settlers, fled, religious, persecution, established, Colony
- 2 How do Pilgrims relate to the story of the first Thanksgiving?

  Native Americans, celebrated, successful
- Are there pilgrimages or similar traditions in your culture?

  Religious, pilgrimages, holy sites, festivals

### Feast

A large and special meal, typically for a celebration.

- 1 What dishes are essential for a Thanksgiving feast?

  Turkey, stuffing, cranberry sauce, mashed potatoes, pumpkin pie
- 2 How do you prepare for a festive feast in your culture? Family members contribute dishes, traditional recipes handed down
- 3 Share a memorable feast you've experienced.

### Cornucopia

A symbol of abundance, often depicted as a horn-shaped basket.

### Harvest Festival

# Cranberry Sauce

Meaning: A sweet and tangy sauce made from cranberries, often served with Thanksgiving meals.

Meaning: A prayer asking for divine favor and protection.


- 1 How do blessings play a role in Thanksgiving celebrations?

# Stuffing

### Pie

Meaning: A baked dish with sweet or savory fillings, typically with a pastry crust.
